

Special Animal Permit Checklist

The following must be received by the City of Canby prior to the requested approval of keeping certain non-domestic animals in the Canby City Limits:

A completed Special Animal Permit Application to include:

- Names, addresses and signatures of all affected neighbors (all neighbors sharing your property lines).
- Please note: Roosters are not permitted inside Canby's city limits.
- o There is a one-time \$10 permit application fee for keeping certain non-domestic animals. The permit, once approved, has no expiration; however, the permit will be immediately revoked if the City receives complaints related to noise, sanitation or other conditions.

Mail the completed form to City of Canby, PO Box 930, Canby, OR 97013; or hand deliver to City Hall located at 222 NE 2nd Avenue, Canby.

Upon receipt of your completed application, the City Administrator will consider your request. You will be notified of his decision.
