Good Driver's Deferred Sentence Program

Court Clerks are authorized to act on the Judge's behalf to reduce fines for select traffic violations. In most cases you need not appear in court. This does not apply to traffic crimes: Hit and Run, Driving under the Influence, Reckless Driving.

The driver must possess an Oregon driver's license (no CDL licenses permitted), and have a clear driving record for the last 5 years (no convictions of any kind).

The program requires the applicant:

- Attend a one-time (3 hour) traffic safety class within 60 days. Price is \$50.00.
- The court will provide you the name of the class provider. They will notify the court of your attendance.
- Pay the court filing fee (The amount on the ticket less \$50.00) within 30 days.
- Receive no other convictions during the next 60 days.

With successful completion, the charge will be dismissed and not recorded on your driving record.

If any of the conditions are not met, the deferred sentence will be revoked.

- Any payments made will be forfeited.
- A conviction will be entered on your driving record.
- You will be billed for the full amount of your ticket.
