Stormwater Management



The City of Canby provides dog waste bags at City Parks to help maintain the health and welfare of our parks and walking paths, and to protect our valuable natural resources from pet waste contamination. When we as a community actively participate in this program we significantly improve the usability of our parks and walking paths. At the same time we are preventing harmful contaminants from entering our streams and rivers, and from contaminating our groundwater. Thank you for your support of these efforts.



The City of Canby is working in our local communities to help coordinate stream side restoration efforts. These projects focus on habitat restoration designed both to protect our waterways from harmful increases in temperature, and to remove invasive species, making way for the restoration of native vegetation.

Managing our stormwater and creating a better temperature of water climate will aid in fish and wildlife habitat.



You will see these buttons at many catch basins throughout the City. The Public Works Department installs these buttons to remind citizens and contractors that the dumping of material into our stormwater system will end up polluting our environment. Please think before you dump – any products that can harm our environment should be disposed of properly.
