**Notice is hereby given that the City of Canby, will receive Statements of Qualifications until 4:00 p.m.
May 30, 2018 for PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL SERVICES.**

The requested work consists generally of the following:

Professional engineering and technical services from qualified traffic planning, engineering, and construction teams, or consultants with demonstrated experience to provide geometric design, traffic counts, reports, right-of-way acquisition, modeling, surveying, geotechnical engineering, structural engineering, complete plan design, cost estimating, construction documentation, construction inspection, technical expertise in both field and office settings, limited project management, specialized inspection, transportation specialist support at public meetings, value engineering, and other transportation planning and engineering services as may be needed by the City.

Future projects may include:

- Design of and construction support for intersection improvements, channelization, sidewalk and ADA Ramps, railroad coordination near RR crossings at S Elm, S Grant and S Ivy Streets
- Design of and construction support for traffic signals and intersection improvements at S Sequoia Way, SE Hazeldell Way and Hwy 99E
- Design, including real estate acquisition, of, and construction support for new roadway connecting SE Hazeldell way to 99E, traffic signal at 99E and reconstruction of SE 1st Avenue between SE Hazeldell Way and S Walnut Street
- Other miscellaneous feasibility studies and/or projects that may include but not limited to; traffic or transportation-related, structural, sewer collections and storm

This request for qualifications (RFQs) shall be used to compile a list of interested and qualified firms who will be ranked in accordance with procedures as outlined in the RFQ. Qualified firm(s) selected will negotiate contract scope and price on an individual project basis as they arise. Do not include any price or cost considerations with this Statement of Qualifications (SOQ).

There will be no pre-proposal meeting for this RFQ.

Statements of qualifications shall be submitted in sealed envelopes and received at the **City of Canby, Administration Department**, no later than **4:00 p.m. PST, May 30, 2018**, addressed to the attention of Jennifer Cline, Public Works Director, 222 NE 2nd Avenue, Canby, OR 97013. **The City does not receive postal mail at this address.** The outside of the envelope shall plainly identify the "RFQ for Professional Engineering and Technical Services" along with the name and address of the Proposer. Faxed or electronic (e-mail) responses will not be accepted. Responses received after the designated closing date and time will not be opened or reviewed.
