Katie Pratt of NW Vernacular reviewed the attached presentation and then opened the meeting up for questions and comments.

Comments from the public:

- The archaeological significance of Knight's Bridge Park should be documented.
- What are the criteria for a national registry nomination?
- What is the (proposed) Willamette Falls and Landings National Heritage Area?
- There should be awards for property owners who rehabilitate/restore historic properties.
- Large structures ("monstrosities") that are not congruent with the appearance of downtown in terms of mass, height, and general appearance should not be approved.
- The history of the indigenous people of this area needs to be researched and shared.
- The Logging Trail (Molalla Forest Road) should have interpretive signage.
- When is the 150th event?
- Owners of historic properties that are not designated should not be asked to remove historic components of the structure ("wavy windows) to obtain approvals and permits.
