Minutes of February 26, 2019 Meeting: Approved

New Business:

- Street Trust (formerly BTA) - HB 2682 clarifies that bike lanes continue through intersections and has just passed out of committee. Motion passed to send letter to our state senator and representative in support of this bill. Mindy will prepare letter.
- May Bike and Walk Challenge Month - Proclamation to be read by Mayor Hodson at May 1st city council meeting.
- Calvin said he has contacted Canby businesses to be bike friendly by supplying bike racks and water bottle fills.

Old Business:

- County Bike/Ped - Bruce said that project priorities for the I205 widening and seismic upgrades have been established. ODOT does not want to do expensive bike projects for I205 and usually chooses the least expensive option. Concern was expressed about ODOT's interpretation of their responsibilities under the OR Bike Bill.
- CTV5 - Mindy said we can film public info spots on bike safety, bike gear, bike rides, etc.
- Greg said the access to the logging road at Baker Prairie is on school property and is their responsibility. Any request for improvements should be from our committee chair to the school board chair. Motion approved to send a request for a curb cut on Township Rd to Canby School Board Chair.

Development Updates:

- Calvin said that funding was approved to install water bottle filling station at the Bike Hub.
- Ryan said the RFP for the splash pad at Maple Street Park is going out the first of the month.
- Ryan said the city wants to update its TSP (Transportation System Plan).
