Owners of Ace Glass - taking part in City façade update program

City Council approved repaving schedule 800k for this summer's work Putting out to bid to fix potholes to gun club ODOT pushing back on 99 construction to this fall and into 2 segments Segment 1 ada and sidewalks Segment 2 paving February

City Manager budget coming soon - expect to make some investments - no city layoffs - finished negotiations with City Police

Recession concern -- City has 30% in reserves City funds are from Property Tax, Liquor,

Dog Park - Location decided -- adjacent to Ecco Park -- budget is 600k with 200k contingency. Also includes some facilities to include a flush toilet and

Maple St. - Need 3 days of clear weather to finish Pickle Ball Courts

New city councilor - Art Marine -- very active in the community as a volunteer There will be 3 positions on the ballot in November

Cliff asked about 99E sidewalks -- Greg thinks that there may be a right of way issue but will get details
