City trying to get better communications by streamlining communications through Staff Liason.

Slice of Summer, events in City

Budget. 8.5 new employees including a Fulltime Mental Health position with the Police Department

Dog Park funded. Included In budget is a toilet between Dog Park and Logging Road Trail.

Community Park will be improved with 2 new flush toilets.

Big Investments have come because so much in savings over the past 2 years. After allocations there is 30 million in reserve.

Pickle Courts open, Parks Master plan delayed until July 19.

\$50,000 set aside for mini-grants. Rules not out yet, but examples might be for access by City committees, such as Bike/Ped to seek funds for events etc.

Mural Fund created for murals in downtown.

Paving projects on 99 and road to Traverso being delayed because of the difficulty in finding available contractors.

TRAVERSO PHASE I:

Site visit last week went well. City Staff, Dan Miller, Bike Committee members and neighbors were there. The response was good as property owners were able to convey their thoughts and concerns affecting their property.

Parks Masterplan update: Revised to be ready July 19. The 16 mile biking error in the plan is going to be address by Greg Parker. Greg said there is still 1 million unallocated for Parks. The Dog Park already has funds allocated.

Heritage, Ron said the next Heritage and Landmark committee meeting is July 11.

Grants: Greg said grants, ODOT applications will be held off this round.

Sidewalks: Nothing new on 99, Greg will check on situation with Union Pacific.

Outreach: Britt asked members to post photos from the trail, showing activity, and can also post photos from round Canby.
