Minutes of August 2022 Meeting: Approved, with 2 amendments

New Business/Staff and Council Update

Mindy- Property owners are responsible for maintenance and bush trimming of planter strips adjacent to streets bordering on their property. She suggests we promote an annual a city-wide cleanup day to encourage property owners.
- Greg - Canby presently operates on a complaint basis for clearing foliage encroachment in to the streets. Sometimes public works ends up clearing it. Greg has new tools to address the issue. We should revisit later.

Bruce - Parks master plan submitted to city council and approved. Greg - Scott Archer will combine parks master and Canby Parks and Rec suggestions. City manager to build an implementation plan. Public input is over.

Bruce: Hots Spots – 1.) Canby Logging Road at 4th avenue underpass has been addressed by Canby Public Works with the addition is striping and arrows. 2.) Public works also removed tree limbs encroaching into the bike lane on Sequoia Parkway. 3.) Clackamas County will be addressing cycling hot spot just north of Goode Lane on Ivy street (Hwy 170), south of Canby. “Bikes on Road” signs will be added.

Bruce – Amazon put the planned warehouse and distribution center project on hold.

Greg – 1.) Full time City communications director position is being considered. 2.) Clackamas County is planning to repair Knights bridge during 2023. Also, Clackamas County owns the adjacent 19 acre park which could be an attractive asset for City of Canby.

Tyler- Canby Night Out street dance was a success. Waite Park events for Halloween, Light Up The Night (Christmas) and Oktoberfest are being planned.

Emma, John, Jerry Nelzen and Cliff will be Meeting to arrange for distribution of new Canby development plot plans.

Mindy - Farm workers commute on N Holly St between central Canby to the west. New bike lanes would improve safety.

Greg – Keep this for a future discussion item.

Emerald Necklace we will review the overall plan and what has been done so far

Bruce - ODOT gave a presentation at the Clackamas County Bike and Ped meeting regarding planned tolling of I-205. Tolling stations will be at Stafford Road and Oregon city bridge on I-205. This is important in that traffic through Canby on 99E could increase significantly.

Mindy and/or Bruce plan to assist Emma in writing the ODOT Community Paths grant application.
