Staff update:

Backstop new Restaurant plan approved by City Council

Sidewalks, Cliff observed that new construction between 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> on Knott North is all underground, with no new sidewalks.

Hot Spots Proposed that this become a regular part to B/P agenda. Member look for places with easy fixes rather than larger projects.

Cliff brought up the tree on South Ivy, south of the bridge over the river, should have signs alerting drivers that there will be bikes in the lane as there isn't adequate space on the right side, going South for bikes to safely ride.

On the corner of Holly and Territorial there is no side walk on the East Side of Holly, by the Church. There are no sidewalks on the other side of Territorial either.

Clackamas Safe Routes to school poster contest is on. Mindy sent out information. The winner could go on a Tri-Met Bus.

Maple to Territorial, the City is taking ownership of all of Maple from the County.

Ron Burn reported that a Public Meeting to designate the Train Station Depot as an Historical site will go to City Council. This will be a City of Canby designation.
