Staff and City Council Update

–Walnut connection to 99E is still planned

Old and New Business

–Britt: Rural roads just on the outside of the city borders are seeing increased commercial truck traffic, which makes it less safe for neighboring residents to walk or ride their bikes into town.

–Bruce: Logging Road should be repaved, it's quite rough in areas. Emma will bring this up to Jerry Nalzene.

Development/Sidewalks

–Cliff: What's the status of the South Ivy project–sidewalks from 99E to 13th? Emma will follow up on this.

–Emma: Designs for 10th St. improvements North of the fairgrounds are made.

Outreach

–Britt will also post the county link for the public to give input.

County Update

–Bruce: The county is focusing on 5 regions for enhancing bike/ped access, but our region isn’t one of them. This is an issue. Also, rumble strips should be placed off of the shoulder, by the fog line.
