New Business

Jerry reports:

- Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) adopted by City Council (on City website), and Parks advisory committee plans to update it for parks
- Plans for 2024: Auburn Farms park to be built
- Lighting and turfing at Maple St Park; fitness court at Legacy Park
- S Ivy (99E-11th) to get turn lanes and bikes lanes over 2 years
- Walnut St. connection by Columbia Distributing may start construction this summer. Dog park being considered there.
- Downtown alleys to be improved starting this summer
- Dan asked about possibility of getting a bike path down Holly to Molalla Park. Bruce states it's a county rd, and the path could happen when the area is developed.
- Bruce gave update on county projects: widening on SE 122nd, Milwaukie Monroe project, bike lane improvements of the Sunnybrook I-205 onramp area

Old Business

- Logging Road: Bruce repeats concerns over condition of deteriorating pavement. Jerry has been working with engineers to plan repaving of trip-hazards and damage caused by roots
- Jerry states the Logging Rd could perhaps be included when Pavement Condition Index Ratings are done for roads, he'll research this.
- Discussion about whether Logging Rd could be re-categorized to a street/road, so it could be funded and maintained along with the roads, rather than under Parks. Dan will bring this up to council, may ask if this could even be considered, from a legal standpoint.
- Bruce gave history of Traverso section.

• Emma reports that she's working on getting records of the history of all pedestrian/bike incidents in the Canby area over a period of time.

Outreach

- Britt posted notice for committee member opening on the Logging Road Facebook page, and the Carbs page
- Dan spoke with the new director of Bridging Cultures, who will see if anyone from the Spanish speaking community may be willing to volunteer for the position. This would provide better representation.
