Public Comment: Ray Smucker

Mr. Smucker attended to express his concern and seek an avenue to solve a problem. The problem is speeding on the Logging Road trail. He rides or walks on the trail nearly daily. He has had personal experience with speeding riders, mentioning ebikes as well as road bikes traveling up to, his estimate, 30 mph. He would like to more signing, larger signing about rules of use of the Logging Road, as well as a white line down the center. Also would like to see cameras. The committee told him of the actions the committee has taken re signing and getting a white middle strip on one specific location. The committee let him know that we had reached out to the city for a middle white line, but were told there wasn't money in the budget, with the cost being about \$25,000. The committee will continue to pursue the signage and white line issue. It was also suggested that he attend a City Council meeting and in their public comment period express his concerns. He had been thinking of doing that.

Staff Update: Emma brought the committee up to date on the Comprehensive Plan. She has sent out the plan and we are able to comment, especially on the Transportation section. There will be a meeting about the Transportation Plan on October 22 at 6pm.

New Business: Mindy spoke of freshening up the Bike Hub. Maintenance has fallen off.

Recruitment for committee: Emma says there are two new applicants.

Outreach: Previous member Britt Ash had been our Outreach person, so another member is needed to take on that role as well as get new members as administrators on the logging road trail Facebook Page.
