Minutes from February 10: Approved

New Business: Discussed the lack of sidewalks at Triangle Park, which is on the Canby Women's Historical Trail. It wasn't felt that working on this was practical at this time.

Old Business: CCPBCAC: Bruce reported that Oatfield and Concord in Milwaukie has been identified as a hot spot due to vegetation and debris causing a sidewalk to be impassable Discussion followed regarding who is responsible. Clack. Co. staff to follow up.

City Administrator: Randy said he had received two resident complaints about speeding e vehicles on the Logging road trail. There was discussion on this continuing topic. He has prepared a list "Trail Etiquette for All Users". Copies were given to all in attendance.

Striping on the Bike Trail/Logging Road is on the schedule when weather permits. Randy also handed out a draft of an enclosure for Utility bills regarding sidewalks. He is considering setting up an email, Sidewalks@canbyoregon.gov for the public to contact him and the City about areas of concern. An inventory of sidewalks is a hoped for result of the outreach. Sidewalks are the responsibility of homeowners and other property owners.

However it can be expensive so he is looking at a 50/50 program with the city. Cliff added to Randy's comments with a sheet with recommendations for Cross Walk striping in North Canby. He handed out copies to all in attendance.

Staff update: Ryan sent an email with the draft TSP 20 year look forward plan. He directed us to page 55 for road improvements which includes bike lanes and sidewalks. It is an aspirational document.

General announcement: Bruce said the next Molalla River Watch Clean up is Saturday, April 11 9am-noon.
