**“Grand Opening Announced for Maple Street Park Splash Pad on June 18<sup>th</sup>”**

*City of Canby Parks and Recreation Performing Maintenance in Coming Weeks.*

The City of Canby has announced a Grand Opening for the Maple Street Park Splash Pad on Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 4:00p. Maple Street Park is located at 1300 N Maple Street between Territorial Road and NE 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

The Grand Opening will feature a ribbon cutting ceremony with the Mayor and City Council and the City’s Parks and Recreation Committee. Light refreshments will be served. The community is invited to attend the Grand Opening event.

In the coming weeks the Canby Parks and Recreation department will carry out routine maintenance on the Splash Pad in anticipation of the Grand Opening. Parks and Recreation will be testing and running the system intermittently to ensure it is ready for the event and summertime use. During this time, the Splash Pad will be closed to the public.

While neighboring cities have been able to open their splash pads, Maple Street Park houses the City’s first splash pad with 2021 serving as its inaugural year. The City anticipates the process of testing the system will be streamlined in the future and the splash pad will be opened earlier in the season to correspond with the beginning of warmer weather.
