## Leaf Drop-off Event Scheduled for Saturday, December 3rd

New weekday drop-off offers additional opportunities for Canby residents.

The City of Canby's Public Works Department will hold a free leaf drop-off event on Saturday, December  $3^{rd}$ , 2022 from 9:00 – 3:00p.

Public Works will accept leaves only, please no sticks or yard debris. Loose leaves will be accepted from trailers or truck beds or bagged in biodegradable, paper bags. The drop-off location will be at the Canby Public Works facility, located at 1470 N Territorial Road.

Jerry Nelzen, Public Works Director, said "The Public Works Department is excited to offer this opportunity again to our residents. Mayor Hodson has been a great supporter of these efforts and has remained diligent about reminding the community to not blow leaves into the streets. The leaf drop-off day allows the City to remain good stewards of those efforts."

Beginning Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup> through December 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Public Works Department will also offer weekday leaf drop-off at Public Works every Monday through Thursday between 9:00a and 3:00p, by appointment only.
