Canby Public Works to Host Free Leaf Drop-off Event for Canby Residents

Drop-off Location will be at Canby Public Works Facility

The City of Canby's Public Works Department is holding a free leaf drop-off day on Saturday, November 20th from 8:00a – 4:00p. The drop-off location will be at the Canby Public Works facility, located at 1470 N Territorial Road.

Public Works will accept leaves only, please no sticks or yard debris. Loose leaves will be accepted from trailers or truck beds or bagged in biodegradable, paper bags. The event is for Canby residents only, proof of Canby residency will be required. Please no businesses or contractors.

"The City has wanted to provide this service for a long time, and I want to thank City Administrator Scott Archer for allowing us to provide this benefit to the community," said Jerry Nelzen, Public Works Director. "It is great to be able to provide a location for residents to drop their leaves. We were able to see how the drop-off points helped during the ice storm and that enabled us to put this leaf drop off into motion."

The Canby Public Works department hopes providing this service to residents will help support the local community, as well as help to reduce the wear and tear on the City's street sweeper.

Nelzen continued, "We are excited to see the turn out we have for this drop off event. Hopefully, we can provide more of these events in the future."
