**City of Canby Seeks Prospective Candidates for Canby Mayor and City Council**

*Nomination paperwork will be accepted through August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022.*

The City of Canby is currently seeking nominations for the expiring terms of three City Councilors and Mayor.

The terms of office for Mayor Brian Hodson, Councilor Art Marine, Councilor Greg Parker, and Councilor Shawn Varwig will expire on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. The Mayor and Council Positions will be on the November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, General Elections ballot. The Council positions are four year terms and the Mayor Position is a two year term. The winners of the Mayor and Council Positions will serve terms that commence in January 2023.

“As your City Elections Officer, I am available as resource,” said Melissa Bisset, City Elections Officer. “Should anyone have plans to file their nomination paperwork, or questions about the process, I am available to connect and happy to provide assistance.”

The first day to file with the City Elections Officer (the City Recorder) is June 1, 2022. Nomination papers will be accepted from 9:00a on June 1<sup>st</sup> through 4:30p on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Candidates interested in beginning the process should schedule an appointment with the City Recorder directly at 503.592.6922 or [BissetM@CanbyOregon.gov](mailto:BissetM@CanbyOregon.gov).

Qualified candidates must be a resident of the city of Canby during the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the election, must be a qualified elector in the State of Oregon, and may not be employed by the City of Canby.
