Parks & Recreation Draft Master Plan Now Available on City's Website

City of Canby contracted with BerryDunn to complete the Master Plan

The City of Canby's Parks & Recreation Draft Master Plan is now available on the City's website (please see links below).

The Parks and Recreation Master Plan will examine existing facilities and services to assess the current and ideal future level of services for the community based on public input. The plan will prioritize needs and desires for upgrading and improving parks, recreational facilities, athletic fields, amenities, programs, and services. It will also explore partnerships with other organizations and funding sources.

The Mayor and City Council, Parks and Recreation Master Plan Steering Committee, city staff, and consultants from BerryDunn will meet at a joint Work Session next Wednesday, June 1st to review the plan. In addition to the draft Master Plan, consultants have prepared a Methodology Study to review System Development Charges (SDC) fees.
