"A good rule of thumb is, on average, approximately \$0.67 cents of every dollar spent will stay in the local economy," Stickel continued. "While that might not seem like much, it means the world to our local businesses. That means \$67 of every \$100 dollars spent stays in Canby, or \$670 of every \$1000. The impact is tremendous!"
