NOTICE OF DECISION

Wally's Chinese Kitchen
679 SE 1st Avenue

Decision: The City of Canby Planning Director has **APPROVED** a Non-Conforming Structure application which will allow the reconstruction and repair of the damaged structural awning at 679 SE 1st Avenue.

The City is required to notify all property owners and residents within 100 feet of the site of the decision. Please consider this your notice of decision. According to ORS 227.175, this decision may be appealed to the Canby Planning Commission within ten (10) days of the date this notice was mailed. Request for an appeal must be in writing and be received by the Planning Department by **4:00 p.m. on July 20, 2026**. Following an appeal, a Planning Commission hearing will be scheduled.

Instructions for an Appeal:

- The deadline for an appeal is 4:00 pm on Monday, July 20, 2026.

- There is a \$500 fee for an appeal. The fee is refunded if the appellant prevails at the hearing.
- Appeal documents can be emailed to planningapps@canbyoregon.gov or brought to the Planning counter located on the 2nd floor at City Hall (222 NE 2nd Avenue, Canby).
- An appeal shall clearly state the nature of the decision being appealed and the reasons why the appellant is aggrieved. According to state law, the appeal "shall be raised with enough specificity so as to afford the governing body, Planning Commission, and parties, an adequate opportunity to respond to each issue."
