Real Estate Signs

Temporary signs that meet the standards below do not need a "sign permit".

- Sign(s) on Property For Sale: See physical requirements.
- Additional "For Sale" Signs Off Premises: See open house signs.

Physical Requirements of Real Estate Signs: One temporary sign no taller than 5ft in height, and not exceeding 6 square feet in area for residential zones. One temporary sign no taller than 8 feet in height, and not exceeding 32 square feet in area for commercial/industrial zones. Must be removed within 14 days after sale.

Open House Signs: A-frame and lawn signs no taller than 3 feet in height and not exceeding 6 square feet in area may be displayed on weekends and holidays in right of way in relative close proximity to a property where an open house is being held for the sale or lease of the property. In addition, one temporary sign of any kind no taller than 4 feet in height, and not exceeding 6 square feet in area, may be displayed on residentially zoned property for a maximum of 8 days in any calendar month provided it is removed by sunset on any day it is erected.
