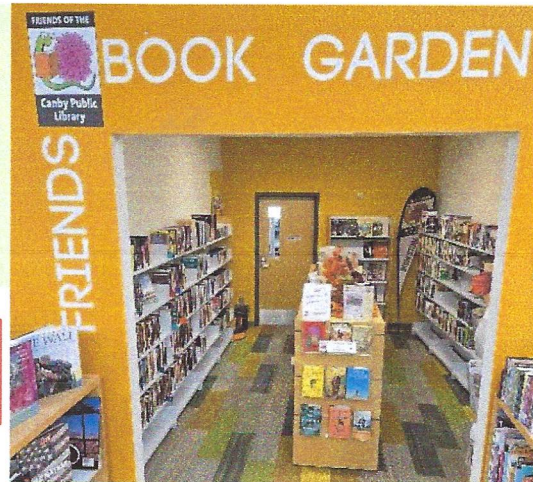

We accept: Books in gently used condition paperback and hardback, children's/youth chapter books, DVDs, Blu-ray and CDs and magazines less than 3 months old.

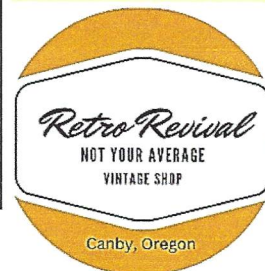

Two donation bins located inside the library near the Book Garden.

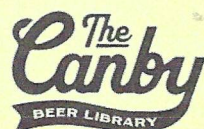
