ORDINANCE NO. 1471

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CANBY MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.56.030 AND 2.56.050 BY CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP AMOUNT FROM SEVEN TO NINE MEMBERS FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.56 of the Canby Municipal Code created a Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to advise the City Council regarding park and recreation related items; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has proposed expanding their membership size from seven to nine members in order to better serve the community; and

WHEREAS, the initial appointment of the eighth and ninth member shall be for a two year term with three year terms thereafter.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 2.56.030 and 2.56.050 of the Canby Municipal Code are amended to read as follows:

§ 2.56.030 Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board shall consist of 7 9 members appointed by the City Council upon recommendation of the Board Chairperson and the City Council Parks liaison. The Mayor may vote only to break a tie, if necessary. Board members shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council. No member of the Board shall have any financial interest, either directly or indirectly, in any contract to which the swim center or Parks Department is a party, nor shall any member receive a salary or any payment for materials or for any services rendered the Board. Board members may be reimbursed by the city for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. (Am. Ord. 1133, passed 2-18-2004)

§ 2.56.050 Officers; procedures.

At the first meeting of each year, the Board shall elect a Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and a Secretary who shall serve for a term of 1 year. Four A majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. The Board shall have authority to make and alter rules, with approval of the Council, for its government and procedures. (Am.
