

ORDINANCE NO. 1671

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BULK FUEL FROM CECO, INC. UNDER STATE OF OREGON PRICE AGREEMENT 0498, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has constructed a new fuel station to support fleet and transit operations;

WHEREAS, the City requires an initial bulk fuel purchase to place the facility into service;

WHEREAS, CECO, Inc., of Portland, Oregon, is an approved vendor under a State of Oregon Price Agreement 0498 for bulk fuel; and

WHEREAS, the use of a State Price Agreement is an allowable cooperative purchasing method under Oregon public contracting law and provides competitive pricing and administrative efficiency.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby as follows:

Section 1. Authorization: The City Council hereby authorizes the Interim City Administrator (or designee) to procure bulk fuel from CECO, Inc. utilizing the State of Oregon Price Agreement 0498, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, and in accordance with Price Agreement 0498 requirements.

Section 2. Funding: The initial fuel purchase to fill the new fuel station shall be funded through the approved fuel station project budget.


Section 3. Due to rising fuel costs, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the public to authorize the procurement of bulk fuel from CECO as quickly as possible. Therefore, the City Council declares an emergency and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment on May 20, 2026.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter, to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, commencing at the hour of 7:00 PM in the City Council Chambers, located at 222 NE 2nd Avenue, 1st Floor, Canby, Oregon.


