## CANBY UTILITY, MAJOR VARIANCE (CITY FILE #VAR 21-03) – PLANNING STAFF – RYAN POTTER

**a.** To consider a proposal from Canby Utility, requests Planning Commission approval of a Major Variance to construct a 10-foot tall security fence as part of Phase II of their previously approved project (DR 17-01), which is currently under construction. The proposed fence height is two feet above the maximum allowed in the M-1 (Light Industrial) zone by the City's Zoning Code.

## STATE STREET MULTI-FAMILY PROJECT (CITY FILE #DR 21-04) PLANNING STAFF – ERIK FORSELL

a. To consider a Site and Design Review application to develop two buildings with 12 residential units, totaling approximately 10,588 square feet on a 0.44-acre site. The proposed development will be accessed off of SW 3rd avenue by the means of an existing easement. Both buildings will be 3-stories in height, approximately 5,294.25 SF. The proposal is to have a total of six (6) two bedroom / two bathroom units and six (6) one bedroom / one

bathroom units. Each individual multifamily structure will have a total of six (6) units with a mixture of one and two bedroom units.
