New Business

Brian Hutchins, Item #1 -

- On S. 13th, Sequoia to Teakwood, the speed limit is 35mph
 - Requesting to lower to 25 to match rest of are
- City owns the North side of the street, and County owns the South side of the street
 - Needs coordination to request County agreement to grant the city request/give permission to change.

Brian Hutchins, Item #2 -

- NW 5th and Cedar near Eccles Elementary needs a no-parking notice on Cedar St
- This needs to be applied to the area before the crosswalk where the sidewalk bumps out into the street (across from the intersection with 5th) and extends down to the Carriage Court apartment entryway, where the sidewalk shifts back again. Parking on Cedar blocks visibility to the crosswalk and the crosswalk signal.
 - Gary motioned to paint N. Cedar across from NW 5th with a No Parking notice. Jenni 2nds.

Cory Carpenter and Rick Brown are in attendance to follow up on Larch St concerns.

Old Business:

Larch Street -

- The data counter was not out in Dec; in the gueue with Public Works for January
- Before/After School, 13th/Ivy arterial backs up to 16th and Ivy

- ~7 months ago, light @ 13th had timing changed, and favors 13th over Ivy now
- Clackamas Co responsible for light timing
- Commission can recommend expediting the study of traffic flow/timing at that intersection
- The city has no speed hump policy
 – generally likes to get neighborhood sign-off to implement

Related to Larch St issues -

- Canby City limits end at S. Ivy, and 18th soon to be 20th.
- Ivy is a County street for now, but the city will control from 99 South to the bridge after development is complete, and sidewalks are installed ~Summer '24".
- The state has allowed Cities and Counties to change speed in their jurisdictions; the conversation led to an agreement to make a suggestion to slow Northbound traffic to 30mph at the bridge.
 - AJ will check with Police Chief that he would support that request
- Make a motion for resolution to request County reduces to 30mph at the next meeting
 - Add to Feb Agenda
 - Ask Members to go to the area and visit for discussion in February

Baker St & NW 6th -

- Clint Can we paint a walk/bike-only area in the asphalt along the edges of the streets?
- Bob Can we add orange flags to the "No Trucks" signs at Knights Bridge/Cedar and Knights Bridge/Ash?
 - Eric motioned to approve; Gary 2nds
- Spencer will look at NW 6th/Baker
 - Can a stop sign on 6th work?
 - o Can we mark the edge of the street?
 - What sign options do we have for notices?
 - Add to Feb Agenda

- Spencer will find a County contact for Gary to talk to about sign concerns
