1. Call Meeting to Order: 8:30AM
2. Introductions:
3. Review and Approval of the October 8th 2025 Minutes (moved by Clint seconded by DeAnna)

4. Citizen Input:
Jerry & Maureen Giger live across from Eccles School and shared their concerns over people not consistently stopping at the stop sign in front of the Eccles School. Desires lighted Stop sign like the one near the Fairgrounds (Our Traffic Safety Commission to schedule a field trip to this location to better understand the situation. Jean Jamison wanted to get an update on the completion of S Ivy after the paving project and discussed concerns over the higher speeds coming into Canby on S Ivy desires the speed limit come down to 30mph and an update on installation of a crosswalk at Ivy and 18th.
