

## CANBY TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

December 10, 2025

1. Call Meeting to Order: 8:30AM
2. Introductions:
3. Review and Approval of the November 12<sup>th</sup> 2025 Minutes (moved by Jennifer / seconded by Clint with the following amendment to correct the spelling of Jeanne Jamison's name / All were in favor.
4. Citizen Input:

Jen Gorski provided a detailed video presentation of accidents and speeding issues related to N Holly St and how it has impacted the livability of the area. We discussed how without the presence of consistent sidewalks it doesn't allow for crosswalks and Ada ramps at this time. Clint made the motion to have the city purchase digital speed signs one for each side of N Holly to be located near 10<sup>th</sup> St / Tom Seconded all were in favor. (Spencer said this would be added to the next Budget Cycle)

5. Old Business:
  - a. Sequoia Parkway concerns re: Trucks parked (Public Works has addressed concerns with Contractors)
  - b. Canby Truck Routes: Gary to talk with retired ODOT Employee for input and recommendations.
  - c. Overgrown Shrubs on N Holly obstructing stop sign view on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> St (City to address and put out door-hangers notifying residents of the issue with plans to correct the problem.
  - d. Reduced Speed Limit on S Ivy / Spencer said once the City takes over S Ivy from the County and submits their speed reduction requests along with their crosswalk work the speed reductions will likely take place next Summer 2026.
6. New Business:
  - A. Jerry & Maureen Giger concerns over people not stopping at the stop sign in front of the Eccles School, providing a real hazard for pedestrians of all ages. We did an online review of this intersection. Clint pointed out that with the School Bus parking in front of the School it towers over the stop sign so drivers can't see it to stop. Clint

made a motion to request the Eccles School require Buses parking in front of the School to park back a full Bus length to allow drivers to be able to see the stop sign. / Jennifer seconded this motion / all were in favor. It was also suggested that the Orange Triangles be placed on all the stop signs at this intersection to gain greater attention for stopping. / Spencer added the rubber Stop signs in road Don't last long enough to be effective long term.

7. City Staff Reports:

- A. Canby Police: Officer Davis report for Nov: 60 DUII's / 173 Citations / 14 Crashes / 10 Traffic Complaints.
- B. Canby Public Works: Spencer reported progress on Walnut Extension Project working through its approval process / Everyone excited about S Ivy being finished and progress on other projects including connecting walking trail bridge pathway to Fred Meyer.
- C. Canby Planning: Brianna reported Canby Planning Dept is still down one Planner / No specific tenants to report for new large industrial project.
- D. City Council Liaison: Traci reported City is working on another Civic Leadership class of approx. 25 (Very valuable exercise for Citizens who wish to get more involved in our community) Mayor and Council members along with some of our County Commissioners are aware of our Commissions Safety concerns related to Hwy 99E Near South End Rd and are interested in reviewing the Speed Review once complete by ODOT.

8. Board Member Reports:

- A. DeAnna: Reported on her appreciation for our Cities Public Works, Police and Fire (Everyone echoed her praise)
- B. Gary: Shared his concerns regarding speeding on N Holly and the need for safety measures given the increased development which will add more vehicles.
- C. Clint: reported having reached out to ODOT for a review of Hwy 99E from Madrona Lane on Hwy 99E to Southend Rd will report back to our group with their input.
- D. Jennifer: reported on the process to remove vehicles from lot on the corner of SW 3<sup>rd</sup> & Grant.
- E. Tom: reported on St Marker sign at Ivy & NW 6<sup>th</sup> St also parking near Lee School on S Ivy Stacking problem for cars delivering and picking up students.
- F. Tina: reported desire dedicated turn light for Berg Parkway & 99E.
