### 2. Introductions:

- 3. Approval of the June 11, 2025 Minutes: Moved by Clint / Seconded by Tom with the following Amendments:
  - a. Spencer Pollack recommended 30mph Speed Limit on both sides of S Ivy Street once the project is complete.
  - b. Tom O'Brien recommended correction of the term pump out to bump-out.
- 4. Citizen Input: David Devore from the new development: Marks Place at Tofte Farms shared his concerns about cars using their neighborhood as a pass thru. Concerned for the safety of Children at play, and overall Safety of Citizens in the neighborhood.

He provided several recommendations:

- a. Add a 4way Stop at Pine & 17th
- b. No thru street for 17th
- c. Require Developer to complete "Loop Road"

Canby Traffic Safety Commission Members are encouraged to visit the neighborhood to better understand David's concerns and be prepared to discuss suggested next steps.

- b. Crash Data for Hwy 99E & Southend Rd. (Officer Davis is waiting to hear back from ODOT with the data)

- a. Traffic counts on N Holly/average speed 28mph to 29mph (a further discussion of what intersections would be eligible for Crosswalks across N Holly given the inconsistency of ADA Ramps and Sidewalks. Clint Suggested Possible Crosswalk locations of 9th/10th and 12th / Spencer to review and comment at our next meeting.
- b. Stop sign at Pine St along with signal on Pine and 99E. (Councilor Hensley shared there are plans in the works to change the intersection

at Pine near the Historic Train Station Museum which would improve traffic flows and overall safety - these will be addressed in the new

Transportation Systems Plan / TSP)

- a. Canby Police: Officer Davis reported 295 Citations were issued in June / 19 Traffic Complaints / 12 DUI's.
- b. Canby Public Works: Spencer reported on many projects NE 10th Piping and Paving project, S Ivy Project along with the 4th of July in Canby just to name a few.
- c. Canby Planning: Ryan reported on the home on 4th SW Elm is being restored to it's Original state and is on the Canby Historic Registry. He said the new Grocery Outlet will open on July 24th. and an Open House for the City of Canby Transportation Systems Plan TSP will be help on Aug 19th at Ackerman School.
- d. Canby Council Liaison: Councilor Hensley said the interim City Manager is reaching out to the Cities various committees and will help our City Leaders during this transitional period until a permanent City Manager is on board.
