January 14, 2026

1. Call Meeting to Order: 8:30AM
2. Introduction:
3. Review and Approval of December 10th, 2025, Minutes (moved by Clint / seconded by Tom with the following amendments to correct the spelling of Spencer's last name and the correction of the Date of our January Mtg on the Minutes / All were in favor.
4. Citizen Input: No Citizens present for Input.
5. Old Business:
 - A. Canby Truck Routes: Gary to talk with retired ODOT Employee for input and recommendations.
 - B. Reduced Speed Limit on S Ivy / Spencer said once the City takes over S Ivy from the County and submits their speed reduction requests along with their crosswalk work the speed reductions will likely take place next Summer 2026.
 - C. South End Rd & Hwy 99E Speed reduction / Clint reported he is waiting to hear back from ODOT on their speed review of this area and their recommendations.
6. New Business:
 - A. Jerry & Maureen Giger concerns over people not stopping at the stop sign in front of the Eccles School, providing a real hazard for pedestrians of all ages. We did an online review of this intersection. Clint pointed out that with the School Bus parking in front of the school it towers over the stop sign so drivers can't see it to stop. Clint made a motion to request the Eccles School require Buses parking in front of the school to park back a full Bus length. (December Mtg) Councilor President Hensley reported she attended Canby School Board Mtg with request to move Buses back. School Board Agreed to move back ½ Bus length (We hope this will help the visibility and safety).
 - B. Installation of two Digital Speed Signs on N Holly St / Spencer reported the funding request for this will be in the next Budget Cycle.

7. City Staff Reports:

- A. Canby Police: Officer Davis report for Dec: 9 DUI's / 199 Citations / 11 Traffic Complaints. Online Complaint system is working well. / Canby Police Dog Sugar is doing a Great job and is a welcome addition to the Team (Yellow Lab)
- B. Canby Public Works: Spencer reported progress on Walnut Extension Project working through its approval process / City Crews Worked Extremely Hard with many hours to combat the challenges from the recent heavy rains. Reported progress on many projects throughout the city. Including connecting walking trail bridge pathway to Fred Meyer Complex. Spencer also reported that Jerry Nelzen has moved on to Silverton. We all wish Jerry well and have appreciated his many contributions to Canby....
- C. Canby Planning: Brianna reported Canby Planning Dept has identified a new Planner to add to their Team / Application for 7 Unit Condo near Fairgrounds / Planned Memory Care Facility near Hope Village perusing Traffic Study. / Excited to share new Ramp off logging trail to connect to Fred Meyer Complex to open soon. Walnut connection is seeking a Contractor to complete Roadway Project.
- D. City Council Liaison: Traci reported City is working on ideas for Old Senior Center and Swim Center Location. (looking at Sherwood and Newberg) New Senior Center location is likely a year away from completion. We all want to Thank all of our City Staff members, leaders and volunteers for all they do for our community.

- A. DeAnna: Reported on her concern over the need for a dedicated turn light a South Berg Parkway and 99E.
- B. Gary: Shared his ideas for increased signage to reduce speed / Councilor Hensley and Officer Davis shared the limitations to this idea. / continues to research Truck Route solutions.
- C. Clint: reported having reached out to ODOT for a review of Hwy 99E from Madrona Lane on Hwy 99E to Southend Rd will report back to our group with their input.
- D. Jennifer: reported on the process to remove vehicles from lot on the corner of SW 3rd & Grant. It feels like some progress is being made.
- E. Tom: provided a report from Canby Disposal on Preferred Garbage, Recycling and Yard Debris Can placement in Roadway to keep sidewalks clear for Pedestrians.
- F. Tina: reported desire dedicated turn light for Berg Parkway & 99E.
