1. Call Meeting to Order: 8:30AM
2. Introductions:
3. Review and Approval of January 14th, 2026, Minutes (moved by DeAnna /seconded by Tom All were in favor.)
4. Citizen Input: Jeanne Bristol shared her concerns regarding speeding on the triangle near the Fairgrounds on NE 3rd / N Ivy St / N Locust / absence of speed signs / Very Concerned for the safety of Children, Pets and Adults.
5. Old Business:
 - A. Canby Truck Routes: Further research and discussions regarding solutions will continue.
 - B. South End Rd & Hwy 99E Speed reduction request / ODOT has said they are reviewing our request and will provide input once complete. / Clint will update the group as soon as he has received information back from them.
 - C. Jerry & Maureen Giger request for Bus Stop in front of School be moved back from the Stop Sign. Eccles School has agreed to move the Bus Stop back to allow greater stop sign visibility. (We hope this change will improve safety in front of the school and will follow this issue to see if more safety measures are needed)
6. New Business:
 - A. Concerns regarding U Turns on Hwy 99E and N Redwood / The Canby Police Dept are aware of our concerns. (Further discussions to continue to identify best long-term solutions to this problem).
 - B. Advocate for designated turn light at Hwy 99E and Berg Parkway / Our group is in favor of this happening but Input from ODOT is needed to understand what needs to take place for this to happen.

7. City Staff Reports:

- A. Canby Police: Officer Davis report for Jan: 7 DUII's / 289 Citations / 5 Traffic Complaints. Online Complaint system is working well.
- B. Canby Public Works: Spencer reported progress on Walnut Extension Project likely to start in March. Working hard on many projects.
- C. Canby Planning: Brianna reported TSP update will be March 23rd/ Comprehensive Plan Mar 9th Canby Planning Dept reviewing SDC's (System Development Charges) Wally's Chinese Restaurant on Hwy 99E Awning will be replaced soon / New Development on N Holly & Territorial is underway. The Kitty Hawk Bldg. will likely be reviewed and evaluated by the County to provide direction.
- D. City Council Liaison: Traci reported City is working on ideas for Old Senior Center and Swim Center Location. (looking at Sherwood and Newberg) New Senior Center location is likely a year away from completion. Ribbon Cutting for new Logging Trail Connection path Feb 18, @/5pm We all want to Thank all of our City Staff members, leaders and volunteers for all they do for our community.
