 - A. U Turns on 99E & North Redwood / We had a discussion on our safety concerns at this intersection and would like ODOT to investigate safety measures they can implement.

 - C. Canby Planning: Memory Care location at 13th & Ivy working thru the process / Pedestrian study being conducted for S Ivy & Township
