CANBY URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY MEETING MINUTES September 7, 2022

STAFF PRESENT: Scott Archer, City Administrator/Agency Director; Joseph Lindsay, City Attorney/Assistant City Administrator; Jamie Stickel, Economic Development Director; and Melissa Bisset, HR Director/City Recorder.

CALL TO ORDER: Chair Varwig called the Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

CITIZEN INPUT & COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS: Jim Davis discussed the amount of funds that would go back to the City if the Urban Renewal District closed in 2025-26 and how much the Fire Department was losing every year.

CONSENT AGENDA: **Vice Chair Hodson moved to approve the minutes from the June 29, 2022 URA meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Hensley and passed 6-0.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>URA Annual Report</u> – Jamie Stickel, Economic Development Director, presented the FY 2021 Canby Urban Renewal Annual Report. She discussed the Urban Renewal District goals and objectives and FY 2021 project overview including Industrial Park access, downtown quiet zone and gateway arch, former library building, 2021 Façade Improvement Grant program, refinancing of Urban Renewal debt, and maximum indebtedness.

Eric Kytola, Finance Director, explained the increases in incremental assessed value and tax increment revenue, impacts on taxing entities, cash flow projections for FY 2022-26, and estimated increase in assessed value due to development.

There was discussion regarding ending the District earlier, status of the Industrial Park infrastructure, upcoming projects, return on investment, and continuing revitalization.

Chair Varwig adjourned the Urban Renewal Agency Meeting at 6:35 p.m.

Objective: Complete Community Park improvements

Summary

On March 28th the Canby Urban Renewal Agency received four bids for construction of the 2023 Canby Community Park Improvements. This staff report is to request Agency approval for award of the contract.

Background

This project includes construction of two new restroom facilities, a pump station to discharge wastewater to the City's collection system and permit abandoning the existing subsurface system, and the addition of 36 additional parking spaces.

Four bids were received March 28, 2023 as listed below and shown on the bid tabulation attached:

Discussion

This solicitation was advertised and completed in compliance with the public bid statutes in ORS 279C, as a formal bid process. All bids received were reviewed for compliance with the bidding requirements. A minor math error was noted in the highest bid, although it did not impact the low bid or the ranking of the bids. All bids were deemed responsive and responsible.
